Tour Report

With a guide we entered into the cave temples of Ellora and visited so many caves. The Kailashnath temple was the biggest of them. Those all temples were made only in a single rock each. It reminds our Badami cave temples of Karnataka. There were so many caves in ellora but we succeed to see only few of them because reaming was situated in deep hill. After Ellora we went to Ajanta caves. There were the caves which are situated in the mid part of the hill. From the bus stop of Ajanta we left our bus there only and boarded a local bus and moved towards the Ajanta caves bus that bus left us only up to the lower area of the hill. We had reached the caves by staircases. There were 23 caves in Ajanta; there were wonderful paintings in those caves. Among those caves some of them were belongs to Buddhist. We spent more time in Ajanta caves and came back to bus stop. There we spent some more

time for shopping. At evening we left the Ajanta and started moving towards Aurangabad to see the Mini Tajmahal. After 3 hours of journey we reached the Aurangabad and saw the Tajmahal. It was already late so we came out of that Taj mahal very early. After having the special dinner a daba nearby Aurangabad we started our journey towards Vijayapur back. We enjoyed a lot in those tour days with friends and lecturers. We made so many photo sessions and they took part in our journey of life. Really we spent a sweetest time of our life in the tour days. 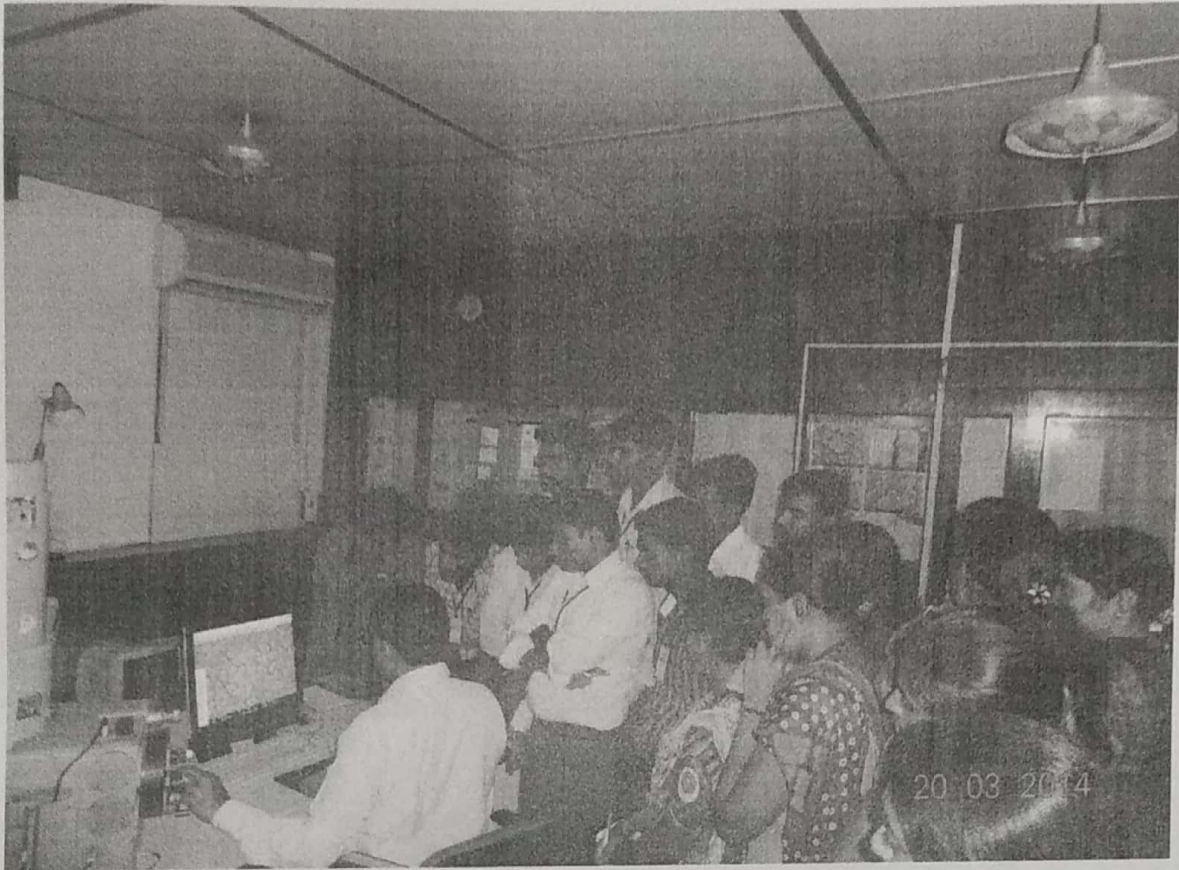
