



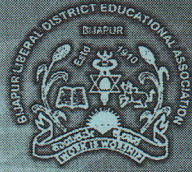

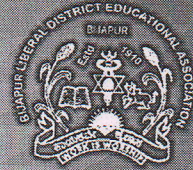

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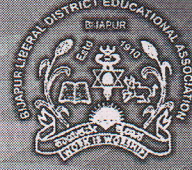
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SYLLABUS

PAPER – I

The main objective is to assess the teaching and research capabilities of the candidates. The test aims at assessing the teaching and research aptitude as well.
