



Summary of the Session: (max. 250 words)


The students gathered in the hall to watch the TED TALK. The speaker in the talk focuses on major issues such as use of pesticides and injections of hormones to fruits and grains that have lead to contamination of the our food. He emphasis that GM foods like BT brinjal, BT cotton, yellow rice, tomato puree soft drinks, noodles, etc are contaminated and are affecting our health. Further, procedure of process and government economic policies are also leading to farmer's suicide in the country.


The speaker being an agricultural scientist has tried to find a ray of hope in the troubled scenario by establishing A Centre for Sustainable Agriculture in 2004. The centre through its initiatives has motivated farmers to stop using pesticides thereby making villages such as Dorli, Eenabhavi, and Kurukulla in Andhra Pradesh pesticide free. In addition by establishing Farmer Co operative Society 'Sahaja Aharam', farmers are selling seeds and fertilizers directly into the market. There are 20 such farmer's co operatives that are helping farmers. Through such initiatives and motivation the mindset of the farmers and consumers can be changed and awareness among people can be created to choose the right food to safe guard health.


Key Message: Organic Farming is the need of the hour.

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
