Patil, HOD and Faculty of P.G Studies in English chaired as the President and Dr. Danayya Kauntagimath the breathtaking achiever who holds a Guinness World Record for clearing 24 SET exams and NET for Thrice- was chaired as the Chief Guest. The First Day of the Workshop had Six Technical Sessions: the first Five Sessions were handled by Dr. Danayya Kaunagimath on Paper I, covering the wide range of topics on Ten Fields which gave panoramic details and information to the aspirants about cracking the Paper I.
