
The Semester Recrudesces with.....

The Resource Person, Dr. Vishnu Shindhe, Professor Education Department, Akkamahadevi Karnataka State Women's University, Vijayapur, eloquently persuaded the vivid acumen of curriculum and the ways to design it. He paved new revolutionary ways of approach to regulate authentic changes in the implementation and development of the Curriculum. The connoisseur held a voice to abandon the traditional way and imbibe spiralness in teaching process. The curriculum, he said teaching should be connected to National, State and Local liabilities and also Compartmentation of the subjects should be evaded and linking of the courses was recommended by him. Later, the IQAC Co-ordinator, Dr. U. S. Pujeri also enrolled with the thought of innovation in the curriculum design so that teaching would become more interactive. This practice, he said, would bring a natural flow in the Education System and revive the skill-based technique. This is the means of New - Ethical- Based -India.
