The Department of Hindi organized One-Day Workshop on the topic "Framing of Hindi Curriculum" on 5-2-2019 .The Inaugurator Dr.Vishnu M.Shinde ,Dept. of Education, Akkamahadevi Women's University, Vijayapur speaking on this occasion explained the importance of having a right Curriculum. He added , Education prepares the students for the real life and real problems. Education is necessary to take into account those abilities, attitudes, habits and all appreciations and forms of knowledge. Curriculum is the design that allows us to plan academic activities.

The Keynote Speaker Dr.Meenaxi Bali, Professor Department of Kannada Women's College, Gulburga talking on the Framing of the Curriculum opined Curriculum as syllabus, principally refers to content. 




