DESCRIPTION

Asparagus racemosus is a climber having stems up to 4 m long. Its roots are both fibrous and tuberous. Shatavari has small pine-needle like phylloclades (photosynthetic branches) that are uniform and shiny green. In July, it produces minute, white flowers on short, spiky stems, and in September it fruits, producing blackish-purple, globular berries. It has an adventitious root system with tuberous roots that measure about one meter in length, tapering at both ends, with roughly a hundred on each plant.

MEDICINAL USES

Tuberous root are used in nervous disorder, tumours, fatigue, diarrhea, fatigue. It is also used in cases of gastric ulcers and indigestion. It has Antifungal, antimicrobial, diuretic properties.
